



Dale's Concessions is a family owned and operated concession stand business that travels all over Monroe County to different fairs, car shows, and festivals. I started off as a "runner," working in the back of the trailers. That included the responsibility of cutting all of the french fries, while simultaneously gathering the supplies the individual trailers needed from our stock trailers. This included any food restock, supply restock such as cups and straws for drinks, napkins, condiments such as ketchup, salt, pepper, and cheese sauce. I needed to supply the trailers with bottled drinks such as gatorade, water, and iced tea. After my first year, I got moved to working inside the trailers.
